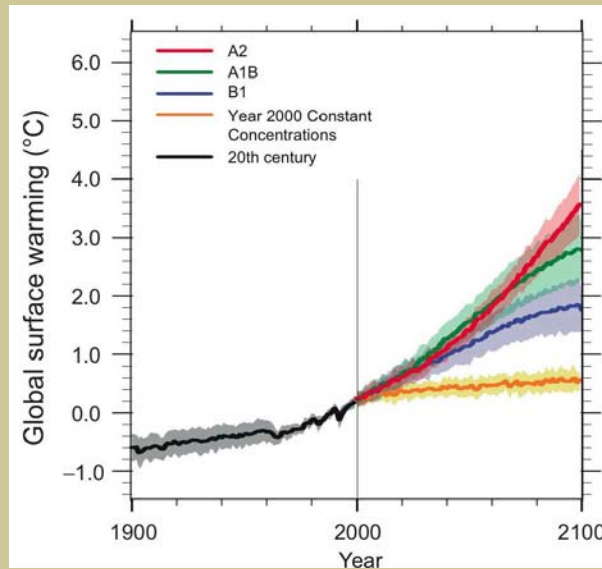
IPCC, Climate Change 2007 Synthesis Report

- “Warming of the climate system is unequivocal, as is now evident from observations of increases in global average air and ocean temperatures, widespread melting of snow and ice, and rising global average sea level.”
- “There is very high confidence that the net effect of human activities since 1750 has been one of warming.”
- “There is high agreement & much evidence that with current ... practices, global GHG emissions will continue to grow over the next several decades.”

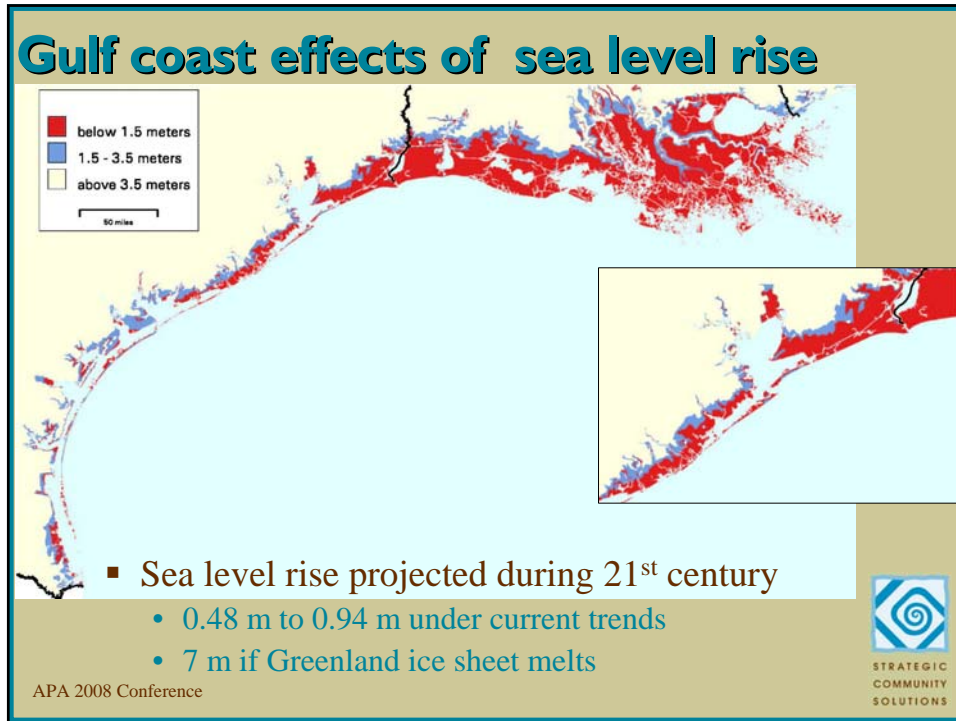

- To support efforts to include climate change in municipal, county, regional plans
- To support action on local initiatives
- For planning leadership within your community or region
